General Guidelines for Scholarship Awards: It is the intent of this scholarship committee to establish a perpetual scholarship program for students having financial need.

1. Applicant must be a resident of Somerset, Wicomico or Worcester County and a graduate of one of that county's high schools.
2. Applicant must be a full-time student at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore.
3. Applicant must have obtained sophomore classification with a minimum grade point average of 2.70.
4. Applicant is required to submit a completed scholarship application.
5. Applicant must submit a statement of need from the University's Office of Student Financial Aid.
6. Applicant must submit a transcript of grades and credits earned.
7. Applicant is required to write a one-page narrative of his or her determination to be successful, as well as the need for financial assistance.
8. A former awardee who wishes to receive the scholarship must re-apply.
9. Scholarship funds awarded to each student are to be used to defray tuition, books and educational fees. Other uses of these funds may be granted at the discretion of the committee and financial officer.

Note: After awards have been granted, the Tri-County Treasurer will send a check directly to the University to be applied to the student's account.

10. Applications may be obtained online or from the UMES Office of Alumni Affairs.
11. The deadline for the Scholarship Committee to receive applications is January 15th. The committee will make a final selection and notify awardees by January 29th.
12. It will be an option of the committee to request an interview with each applicant or finalist.
13. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
14. All applications should be mailed to the Tri-County Alumni Association President or Scholarship Chairperson.
