Gross Anatomy Pre-matriculation Preparation Workshop

The newly accepted students to the Physician Assistant Program recently completed the Gross Anatomy Pre-matriculation Preparation (GAPP) Workshop. The GAPP workshop is a 3 1/2 week program that prepares future physical therapy, physician assistant, medical, and dental students for the pace, content, depth, and volume of a health professional gross anatomy course.



The students are provided the opportunity to study the anatomical structure and function of the thorax, lower extremity, and brain through lecture, readings, dissection of a cadaver, and the utilization of models, skeletal materials, and videotapes. The workshop also includes discussions regarding effective and productive study skills/tips and learning methods.
