- ✓ If you are taking Comps in January, you must be register for Spring Semester Comps #700 (1hr.)
- ✓ If you are taking Comps in June, you must register for Summer Semester Comps #700 (1 hr.)
- ✓ Those who have passed “Comp Exam” you may register for dissertation credits:
 - ORLD → ACOL 899, GVOL 899, HSOL 899

1 – 6 hour per semester to coincide with 12 hours total and your projected graduation date.

In order to sit for “Comp Exam” you must have *completed all Core / Strand and Internship hours with B or better grades*; called **“Good Standing” and must be **registered** for Comp Exam #700 (1hr.)**

At all times, students must be registered for a minimum of 1 hour to remain in the program. If all courses completed, use Comp #700 to stay officially with guidelines.

If you have maxed out on dissertation credits (limit 20) register for ORLD 688.
