

## **ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS (AP)**

UMES awards AP credit based on the chart below. *A minimum score of 3 is required to grant credit.* To receive an award of AP credit, students must provide an official score report to UMES. Credit earned through AP may be used to satisfy the General Education requirements, satisfy course prerequisite and as elective credit.
