CAREER PLANNING SERVICES

The Office of Career Services and Cooperative Education provides career development programs and activities for the entire campus community including undergraduate and graduate students, alumni, faculty and staff.

The Career Services Professionals are prepared to assist you: ♦ with the selection or affirmation of your choice of an academic major, ♦ in identifying your professional interests and work values, ♦ in exploring various career options, ♦ in developing strong job search and decision-making skills and ♦ with your overall transition from student into the world of work.

Either in a group or in one-on-one sessions, students get involved in: ◆ exploring and defining career interests, goals and objectives, ◆ writing effective resumes, cover letters and autobiographical sketches for graduate school and employment, ◆ developing effective interviewing skills, ◆ matching work-related values with possible career options, ◆ discovering pertinent information about employers, and ◆ securing internships (related and unrelated to academic majors), cooperative education placements (related to academic majors), summer, part-time and full-time, temporary and permanent employment.

Resumania

Assistance in developing and preparing resumes is provided for all students. A step by step guide entitled The-Resume Handbook, "Navigating Your Career With an Effective Resume" is available for each student and may be accessed via the internet at the following website, (http://www.umes.edu/careers/). Special times throughout each semester, are set aside by the staff to work with students either by appointment or on a walk-in basis, to critique and refine resume drafts. These group sessions help prepare students to enter the workforce. Individual appointments are available for those students who require assistance with resume writing and interviewing skills.
